The **Union Hospital Family Medicine Residency** program, located in **west-central, Indiana**, has two openings for faculty members. This long-established, unopposed residency program has an expertise and focus on preparing physicians for rural practice and, more recently, for international service.

The mission of the Union Hospital Family Medicine Residency (UH-FMR) program is to prepare and train primary care physicians for successful rural, international or other underserved-area practice through a comprehensive, fully-accredited training program in family medicine. The UH-FMR program is designed to prepare and train residents through a comprehensive family medicine residency curriculum that enables graduates to successfully practice anywhere in the United States – and in the world – especially in underserved communities where resources are scarce. Toward this end, incorporated as a part of the more traditional family medicine residency curriculum are accredited Rural Training Track (RTT) and International Training Track (ITT) curriculums.

The curriculum includes extensive OB training, an optional operative OB fellowship, and procedural training, including endoscopy, skin procedures, colposcopy and vasectomy. Opportunities included for both allopathic and osteopathic trained physicians. The curriculum also includes state-of-the-art training through, for example, an evidence-based chronic disease management program that is fully integrated with our existing electronic medical records system. In addition, the UH-FMR has an expertise in teaching and utilizing cutting-edge technology as a tool for providing state-of-the-art care even while practicing in remote areas. For example, laptop computers, handhelds (PDAs), an electronic medical records system and a self-designed telemedicine program are fully integrated aspects of our curriculum.

Recent expansions that include the ACGME-approved International Training Track as well as an increase (beginning in Fall 2007) in the number of medical students in our area, as a part of our Indiana University School of Medicine partnership program, necessitate hiring of faculty members for our residency program. Positions available are as described below:

Associate Director and Section Chief for Obstetrics

We are searching for a full-time faculty person for Union Hospital's family medicine residency. Applicant must be board certified in family medicine and have considerable experience and interest in OB-GYN and women's health, with OB fellowship training a plus. Duties to include supervision of family medicine residents on both inpatient and outpatient services. Other duties to include curricular development specific to OB-GYN and women's health in family medicine. Position includes opportunity to establish limited private practice at either the family medicine center or at the rural training site. Weekend call is 1 in 6 to 7.
