**Indiana: New Novel H1N1 Flu Case
Confirmed**

The Indiana State Department of Health reports one (1) new confirmed case of the novel H1N1 flu in the following county: Marion (1).

This one new case brings the total number of confirmed cases of the novel H1N1 flu in Indiana to 106, with the following county breakdown:

- Daviess (1)
- Elkhart (2)
- Hamilton (2)
- Hendricks (1)
- Lake (33)
- Madison (1)
- Marion (54)
- Porter (4)
- Putnam (3)
- St. Joseph (2)
- Tippecanoe (3)

The breakdown of confirmed cases by age group (years), include:

- 0-4 (18)
- 5-24 (70)
- 25-64 (17)
- 65+ (1)

There are no newly reported hospitalizations associated with the novel H1N1 influenza A virus in Indiana. Since April 20, 2009, there have been five (5) reported hospitalizations and no reported deaths associated with the novel H1N1 influenza A virus in Indiana.
