Indiana: New Novel H1N1 Flu Cases Confirmed

The Indiana State Department of Health reports a total of 267 confirmed cases of the novel H1N1 flu in the following counties:

- Boone (1)
- Daviess (1)
- Elkhart (3)

- Madison (1)
- Marion (106)
- Monroe (3)

There has been a total of 34 hospitalizations associated with the novel H1N1 influenza A virus in Indiana since April 20, 2009. There are currently no reported deaths associated with the novel H1N1 influenza A virus in Indiana.
