Indiana: New Pandemic H1N1 Flu Cases Confirmed

The Indiana State Department of Health reports a total of 273 confirmed cases of the pandemic H1N1 flu in the following counties:

There has been a total of 36 hospitalizations associated with the pandemic H1N1 influenza in Indiana since April 20, 2009. There are currently no reported deaths associated with the pandemic H1N1 influenza in Indiana.
