Indiana: Confirmed Pandemic H1N1 Flu Cases

The Indiana State Department of Health reports a total of 294 confirmed cases of the pandemic H1N1 in the state. There have been three deaths associated with the pandemic H1N1 influenza in Indiana since April 20, 2009.

The Indiana State Department of Health and the Department of Homeland Security are meeting with public health officials and emergency management agency representatives from around the state to prepare for the fall flu season and the possibility of mass vaccinations for the pandemic H1N1 influenza. The first meeting was held on July 27 in French Lick, and the second meeting will be held on August 4 in Wabash, Indiana.
