Here's how to apply:

You will need:

- your employer and **income information**
- **social security numbers** or citizenship information for all those applying in your household
- **deductions** like student loan interest
- **policy numbers and premium amounts** for any current health insurance plans.



Apply online

if it's during Open Enrollment, or if you qualify for a Special Enrollment -

- Visit www.HealthCare.gov and select "Get Started" then "Indiana" to create an account and apply for coverage.
- You will need an email account and access to your email to register with the website.



Apply in-person

Visit a certified counselor in your community for assistance with applying and enrolling in a health plan.
