- Colorectal Cancer is the 2nd leading cause of cancer-related death in the United States.¹
- Getting screened early can save lives by detecting pre-cancer. Black and Hispanic people are typically diagnosed at a later stage in the disease, when it is difficult to treat.²
- Screening starts at age 45, but people can screen earlier if they have a family history or if symptoms are present.³
